

Basic requirements for admission of non-Saudi scholarship students in Saudi universities:

1-the admission requirements, applicable to Saudi students in institutes of higher education, are also applicable to internal and external scholarship students.

2-Taking into account what has been mentioned in paragraph (1), requirements for admission of external scholarship students are as follows:

A-Age of the student should not be less than 17 and not more than 25 years for university level and institute of Arabic language teaching or similar to it, while 30 years for the Master's degree, and 35 years for Ph.D degree. Board of educational institute has the right to make exceptions.

B- Approval from the government of student to study in the Kingdom. This is for the countries, which require the same from Saudi students.

C- The student should not have obtained any other scholarship from any other educational institutes in the Kingdom.

D – Attested certificates and documents by the competent authorities, specified by the educational institutions.

E-To bring Police Clearance Certificate issued by Security agencies of his country.

F-That he should not have been expelled from any of educational institute in the Kingdom.

G- Female student should be accompanied by a *Mahram*, (Relative) as per the rules governing the same, provided that the *Mahram* is covered by a scholarship, or has a regular residency permit (Iqama) or is on the register of any employer, who is in need of his services.

H- He should pass the medical test prescribed by rules & regulations.

I- Educational institute may require recommendation letter from one of the bodies, institutions, or personalities specified by the institution.

3 –The educational institution council sets the executive rules governing the admission of scholarship students from within, taking into account the following:

A- The student shall obtain the approval of his guardian to study in the educational institution.

B- The student should be a regular resident of the Kingdom.

Benefits of Scholarships:

Scholarship student will enjoy the following benefits:

A- Health care for him and his family members, (in case he brings them to stay with him).

B-Two months stipend upon his arrival as "preparation allowance".

C-Three months stipend as "graduation allowance" for shipment of books.

D-The benefits enjoyed by his peers from the students in the educational institution.

E-The educational institution will provide him with discounted meals.

F-Appropriate housing, educational, social and cultural care will be provided.

G-Tickets, as per provisions of Financial Regulations of the educational institute, will be provided.
